The Canadian Football League

Other than two significant interruptions to support Canadian war-time efforts, the Canadian Football League and its direct predecessors/divisions (the IRFU and the WIFU) have been in operation continuously since 1907. Today's CFL East Division has provided over 100 years of football in Canada, while the West Division has been in operation since 1936. In 2015, the CFL's 58th season opener since the January 19, 1958 establishment of a unified game in the East and West will be the league's 4,194th game since then, and overall regular season game #5,324 since the IRFU began back in 1907.

CFL TRENDS • WEEK #1

1. CFL Opening Week Roster Analysis - 2015:

One of the most prominent themes for 2015 is the continued youth movement around the CFL primarily due to fewer long-term veterans in the league. From a high of 26 players in Year #10 or more, that has now fallen to just 17 in 2015. The number of players starting the season on the Injured List has grown from just 64 in 2013 to 92 in 2015. Here are a few roster highlights around the CFL and some significant trends:

- **Total:** 506 players with 92 of those on Injured Lists. In 2014, we started with 493 players.
- **The average CFL player:** 2.62 prior seasons of experience (CFL only), 35 games played (same as to start 2014).
- **Roster turnover from 2014:** 70% of the 506 players returned to their same team in 2015.
- The remaining 30% are 102 first-year players plus another 49 that moved from another club or returned to the CFL after a one-year absence. First-year players make up 20% of our rosters.
- **Injured Lists:** There are 92 players on the IL to start the year; that is up from 79 in 2014 and 64 in 2013.
- The average CFL player is ... **27.2 years of age** (exactly the same as at June 2014).
- Of the **102 first-year players**, 34 came from the 2015 Canadian Draft (34 of the 63 players chosen).
- There are now only 17 players in their 10th year or more, down from 26 10+ year vets in 2013.
- A total of 46% of our roster players are in either their first or second year; up from 44% in 2014 and 42% in 2013.
- Nationals comprise just under 48% of the CFL now – 241 of 506 players.

4. Other Notes & Trends:

CFL Rule Changes - A 40th Anniversary "Reset of the Game"

- 40 years ago this week back in 1975, the CFL recognized two essential parts of our game needed change - punt returns and converts and doesn't that sound familiar? Back then as now, neither event was bringing much excitement and were fairly predictable. 90+% converts made from 17 yards, less than 6 yards a punt return, just two return TDs in the previous 7 years (1968-1974). In 1975 just so you know, Converts came off the 17-yard line and you could only kick. And worse, you couldn't block for punt returners!
- That 1974 edition of the CFL Rules Committee elected to add the 2-point convert in time for the 1975 season and that year there were 29 of them made. Unbelievably that remains the record to this day! The 1-point kick was moved 5 yards closer and from 30 misses in 1974 it went down to just TWO in 1975! And in 2014 how many were missed? TWO. Likely a few more missed in 2015 with the move to the 32.
- The CFL has moved the **two-point convert** to the 3-yard line and there will likely be far more than the 7 made all last year. Maybe even more than the 40-year high mark of 29. The **one-point convert** will now be from 32 yards and the CFL's experience over the last 5 years worth of 31 to 33-yard field goal attempts is right on **83%**. So look for a miss every 4 or 5 attempts but some CFL insiders think that a challenged kicker just may react by doing a little better than that. As far as decision-making goes - go for one or two? A much more compelling argument for two now as clubs **scored TDs about 48% of the time from 3 yards out in 2014**.
- And lastly, the "**return of the punt return**". In 2015, cover teams will be much lighter with the interior linemen unable to leave the line until the ball is kicked. Pre-Season results were promising with the return average in 2015 expected to be well up from 8 yards per in 2014. And what happened 40 years ago? The punt return average **went from 5.3 yards to 10.1 in a single year** and from **ZERO return TDs to SEVEN!** Maybe 2015 will have a similar reset.

Of the last ...

- 13 CFL leading passers (2002 to 2014) ... the title has been won by just **four different QBs**. Only Anthony Calvillo (8), Henry Burris (2), Kevin Glenn (2) and Ricky Ray (1) have led the CFL in passing since 2001. They have also been the only QBs to lead the CFL in **TD passes** over that 13-year period. Of the nine #1 QBs, 8 will start their club's opening game of 2015 now that Travis Lulay appears ready to play for BC once again.
- 5 Grey Cups ... all have been won by a different club. No repeat winner since 2010 (Montreal, BC, Toronto, Saskatchewan & Calgary).
- 8 Grey Cups ... 6 have been won by a head coach who was a **QB as a player**. Former pro QBs won the Grey Cup only 3 times from 1945 to 2006 (Sam Etcheverry 1970, Ron Lancaster 1993 and 1999).
- 4 West Division leading rushers ... all were Canadian players (**Jon Cornish** 3 times and **Jerome Messam**). Add to that **Andrew Harris** who came close and the West is led by National tailbacks.
- 12 East Division leading receivers (# of catches) ... all have come from either Toronto or Montreal. Chad Owens has led the East in each of the last three years with totals of 94, 94 & 86. The 86 catches came in only 11 games – the second highest receptions per game mark in CFL history at 7.8 (Derrell Mitchell – 8.9 per game in 1998).
- 7 CFL Combined Yards leaders ... all have come from either Hamilton (**Brandon Banks in 2014**) or Toronto. Chad Owens' record-setting 4-year run as CFL leader came to an end in 2014 due to injury.
- 15 CFL seasons and 2,357 different players (with at least one game played), only BC's **Ryan Phillips** has managed to play in 180 consecutive regular season games without missing any at all.
- 41 CFL 1000-yard receivers since 2010 (5 seasons) only 3 came last year. It is the lowest number to reach that mark since 1980.
- 2 seasons, no CFL passer reached 5,000 yards; the CFL has not gone 3 straight years without one since 1992.

And finally ...

- **In 9 pre-season games in 2015** with the new penalty rule changes and standards. There were an average of 33.1 penalties per game in pre-season. That is 53% more than in the 2014 regular season and included 14 of the "**Illegally Downfield on a Kick**" calls and another 32 **Illegal Contact on Receiver** calls.



GAME NOTES – TEAM TRENDS



Home Team Notes & Trends:

- **Going for 3 & 2:** The last time that Calgary won the West Division in three consecutive years was from 1992 to 1996 (5 years running) under Wally Buono. They can make it three or more first places spots in a row for just the second time in club history with a repeat in 2015. The Stamps have won 7 Grey Cups but have never won in back-to-back years.
- **Stamps vs Hamilton:** Calgary has won 10 of the last 11 regular season games vs Hamilton. They have won the last 10 home games vs them dating back to a 41-34 Hamilton win Jul 4/04. However, win margins in the last at Calgary were by just 2, 4 and 3 points.
- **16 wins?:** Calgary is the only team in CFL history to ever increase their win total three years in a row with all years having at least 11 wins (11 wins in 2011, then 12, 14 & 15 in 2014).
- **Closing Out Games:** Calgary's record was 11-2 in 2014 when leading after the 3rd Quarter, and **75-9-1 since 2008**.
- **Drew Tate:** Scored 10 TDs in 2014 and became the **first Quarterback to ever lead the CFL in touchdowns** in any season. He tied for top spot with Nic Grigsby of Winnipeg/Hamilton.
- **Bo Levi Mitchell:** The loss in 2014 Week #19 to Winnipeg snapped an 8-game winning streak with Mitchell as Calgary's starting QB. Having come off the bench in Week #20 at BC, he is now **15-2 for his career**, the same record set by **Jackie Parker** in his first 17 starts across 1954-1955.
- **Eric Rogers:** Closed out 2014 in a big way leading Calgary receivers with two TDs in the 2014 West Final win adding 60 yards on 3 catches and another 5 catches for 108 yards in the Grey Cup win over Hamilton. He has now played 4 games for Calgary with **17 catches for 307 yards and 4 touchdowns**.
- **Jon Cornish:** Heads into 2014 looking for a fourth straight CFL rushing title. The last player to do that was Mike Pringle from 1997 to 2000. The only other player to lead the CFL 4 or more times in a row was George Reed from 1965 to 1969. In 2014 he matched Tony Gabriel's mark of three straight Most Outstanding Canadian Awards (1976-1978).

Visiting Team Notes & Trends:

- **Going for 3:** The last time that Hamilton got to the Grey Cup in three straight seasons was 1965 and completed a run of 5 straight appearances. They also got the title game in 1957 through 1959 so a repeat this year would make it strong runs to the Cup in history.
- **Poorest starts to 1st place:** Hamilton finished 1st in the East in 2014 despite a 1-6 opening run. Hamilton matched the existing mark of coming back from 5 games below .500 in 2014, set originally by themselves in 1985 and equaled by BC in 2011:

- **Coach Austin:** Kent Austin has 19 wins in 36 games leading the Ti-Cats – that is the most in a two-year span by the club in 13 years since Ron Lancaster won 20 across 2000-01. Last year's playoff spot made it 5 times in a 6-year span for post-season play. The previous time the Ti-Cats went to the playoffs 5 times in 6 years was way 1996-2001.
- **Home 7-2 & Road 2-7:** The Tiger-Cats were strong at Tim Hortons Field last year going unbeaten at 6-0 in their six home games. Overall, they were 7-2 at home, their best mark since 2001. On the road however, the Ti-Cats have not had a winning record in any of the last 10 years. They were last over .500 on the road in 2004 (5-4).
- **Zach Collaros vs Calgary:** Did not play in either game vs Calgary in 2014 and is 1-0 in his career vs the Stampeders overall (a win with Toronto on Sep 21/13 in which he threw a career-high 4 TD passes). This will be his second career start at McMahon Stadium.
- **Missing stars:** The Tiger-Cats will be missing their leading receiver, rusher and QB sacker from 2014. Luke Tasker's 937 yards topped club while Eric Norwood had 13 sacks which was #2 in the CFL overall last year. Mossis Madu rushed for only 348 yards in 2014 which was #1 on the club and he too is on the IL this week.
- **Brandon Banks:** Snapped Chad Owens' grip on the CFL's lead for combined yards in 2014. Owens had won each year from 2010 to 2014. In the 2014 East Final, Banks set or tied three CFL playoff records: 1) Two punt return TDs in one game; 2) Most combined yards with 294; and, 3) Most punt return yards with 226. He returned 5 punts for gains of 13, 26, 6, 93 (TD) and 88 (TD) yards.

A rematch of last year's Grey Cup will kick off the 70th regular season in Calgary Stampeders history.

It's the third time the Stampeders have opened the defence of a Grey Cup championship by facing their opponent from the previous season's championship game. Following their 1992 title, the Stamps faced Winnipeg in the 1993 season-opener and Calgary followed up its 2008 Grey Cup by facing East Division champ Montreal in the first game of the 2009 campaign.

In addition to the 20-16 Grey Cup victory over the Ticats on Nov. 30 at Vancouver's BC Place, the Stamps beat Hamilton twice in regular-season play a year ago — 10-7 at McMahon on July 18 and 30-20 in Hamilton on Aug. 16. The Stamps have won 10 straight home games against the Ticats with the most recent Hamilton victory at McMahon dating back to July 4, 2004.

Both teams were undefeated during pre-season play as Calgary recorded wins of 20-6 against BC and 37-29 against Saskatchewan while Hamilton downed Ottawa 37-10 and Winnipeg 26-15.

2 STAMPEDEERS HISTORICAL NOTES

- Today's game is the 1,137th regular-season game in Stampeders history. The Stamps have 606 wins, 511 losses and 19 ties since 1945. Calgary has played 568 games at home, with a record of 356-202-10, and 568 games on the road (250-309-9)
- This will be the 88th meeting all-time between the Stampeders and Tiger-Cats. The Stampeders are 57-30 all-time against the Tabbies including 34-9 at home
- The Stamps are 9-1 in their 10 most recent regular-season games against the Tiger-Cats and 10-0 against Hamilton in the 10 most recent meetings at McMahon Stadium
- The Stampeders hold an all-time regular-season record of 12-9 in the month of June including a 1-1 mark on June 26
