GAME NOTES – CFL NOTES & TRENDS



The Canadian Football League

The CFL was formed on **January 19, 1958** creating a unified game in the East and West. That merger has continued a long football history in Canada and since the IRFU began back in 1907 (and the WIFU in 1936), this will be regular season game #: **5,357**.

1. CFL TRENDS & HIGHLIGHTS – THROUGH WEEK #8:

- Defence Re-Emerges:** Week #8 was a great week for the **defence** for most teams as net offence averaged only a combined 561 yards per game – **the lowest average yards allowed per game in any week since 2002**. Here are some examples of how CFL defences dictated the outcome of games last week:
 - Calgary forced Ottawa into 11 straight 2-&-outs and 11 consecutive incomplete passes in their 48-3 win.
 - In a stretch of 7 drives, Edmonton limited Montreal to MINUS one yard.
 - Winnipeg held Toronto to just 72 yards of offence in the second half but lost on the strength of an Argo punt return TD.
 - Edmonton held Montreal to 2-of-17 on 2nd down conversions (12%) including their first 13 chances. They went 2-&-out 11 times.
 - Hamilton started by forcing BC into 5 straight 2-&-outs and 36 net yards on BC's first 7 possessions.
 - Hamilton had 3 return TDs vs BC including "pick six" #6 leaving them now only one short of the CFL record of 7 (Toronto: 2006)
- Long-range Field Goals:** Last year, only three clubs made a 50+ yard field goal. In 2015, six teams have already at least one. From 50+ yards in 2015, CFL kickers are 11-of-14 for a **78.6%** mark. What is REALLY odd is that from 40-49 yards they are only 32-of-46 for **69.6%**. In 2014, there were only **14 tries from 50+ yards made in 81 games** and just 7 were made for 50%.
- Penalties Update to Week #8:** With only **75 penalties**, Week #8 averaged just **18.8 calls per game**. That is the lowest of the 2015 season and lower than any total from the first 8 weeks of 2014. The cumulative penalty average year-to-date dropped for the 7th straight week to **25.06 per game**.
- Red Zone Defence vs Winning:** The Top **4 Red Zone Defences** in the CFL (Edmonton, Toronto, Calgary and Ottawa) have a combined TD% allowed rate of **46%** and a W-L record of **19-9 .679**. They have turned back more than half of the opposition chances inside the 20-yard line. The remaining clubs are at **60%** only in Red Zone Defence with a **13-23 .361** W-L record.
- QB Sacks / Drives with Sacks:** Last week there were **34 sacks**, the most in any week in 2015. Updating the number of drives where a club allowed a sack: now up to 154 possessions with at least one QS allowed and only 3 TDs made on them (1.9% TD rate).
- QB Sacks Doubled:** CFL QB Sacks per game – Weeks #1-6: **4.1** per game; Weeks #7-8: **8.1**, almost twice as many.
- 2015 Converts Analysis:** The run of consecutive 1-point converts made took a hit last week as after making 41 in a row, CFL kickers made only **13-of-19 attempts**. Six of the seven kickers who had an attempt missed one so it was virtually across the board. For the year, the success rate dropped from 87% and rising back down to 84%.

- 2-Point Converts:** The convert choices made by teams has taken a very odd turn in the last 3 weeks with kicks dominating. Despite the 73% two-point success rate, in the last 12 games teams have elected to kick after **50 of the 54** touchdowns scored, or about **8% of the time going for two**. That sounds a lot like the 6.4% election rate for two-point converts in 2014 (23 of 359).
- Punting remains Up:** The average punt in the CFL this season is **45.4** yards, up a full yard from last season. But that's not the only story as last week as punters trapped opponents inside the 20-yard line **20 times** and **inside the 10 on 8 occasions**. Calgary's **Rob Maver** had a spectacular week vs Ottawa with **THREE** punts out of bounds inside the 10-yard line (10, 1 & 1 yard lines) and another which was fumbled at the Ottawa 6.
- Taking More Penalties – 1 win in 4:** Out of 32 winning teams in 2015, only 8 of them took more penalties than their opponents (25%). Looking at it the other way, the losing club has taken more penalties 18 times so far (6 games were even).



GAME NOTES – CFL NOTES & TRENDS



1. CFL TRENDS & HIGHLIGHTS – THROUGH WEEK #8:

- **Saskatchewan's Injured List – 626 career starts:** Looking at their Week #7 roster provides some insight into Saskatchewan's 0-7 record. They had 15 players sit out the Aug 8/15 loss to Toronto who have a combined 927 games of prior CFL experience. In those players, Saskatchewan was missing a total of **626 career starts** – almost half as many as the 46-man roster that were active. A good comparison can be made to BC's roster last week – just 7 players on the IL with a combined **55 career starts**.
- **100 Games Started Milestone:** Calgary's **Juwan Simpson**, Montreal's S.J. Green and Toronto's Dave Stala are each one start away from 100 GS, Simpson's teammate **Keon Raymond** made career start #100 last week as Ricky Foley of Toronto.
- **Third Down Gambles:** Results in 3rd-and-1 situations this season have shown a marked change from the last few years with a much lower success rate. The trend shows a drop from 84% success rate in 2013 to just **63% in 2015**:

- **Plenty of QBs:** Last week, **15 different quarterbacks** ran at least one possession week highlighting the need for depth at that position. With the debut start of Winnipeg's **Robert Marve**, in 2015 there have been **14 different QBs start at least one game**. At present, there are SIX #1 QBs sidelined with injury: Ray, Durant, Willy, Glenn, Crompton and Reilly.
- **Comebacks – 8 from 10+ points:** In 2015 there have already been 8 teams come back from deficits of 10 points or more. By team: Toronto 2, Calgary 2, BC 2, Ottawa 1 and Edmonton 1. Last year there were only 12 all season.
- **Saskatchewan 2 Takeaways a record low:** The Riders have just 2 takeaways this year (one interception and one on downs). The all-time CFL season-low is held by Edmonton in 2006 with 25. Saskatchewan will have to create 2.1 opponent turnovers per game the rest of the way just to reach that mark this year.
- **2nd down conversions dropping:** In the first six weeks, CFL clubs converted at **49.8%** far above last season's all-time low of just 42.2%. Defences are catching up now and over the last two weeks the conversion rate has been just **41.7%**.
- **Other Milestones:** **Weston Dressler** is 3 catches short of 500 for his career but missed the Riders' last game; **Nik Lewis** is now only 77 receiving yards behind Arland Bruce III (11,625 yards). Lewis' has a career total of 11,548 yards on 830 receptions;
- **Receptions %:** Among wide receivers, **Marquay McDaniel** leads all with a 80.5% mark with 33 catches on 41 targets. **Andy Fantuz** is next at 78.9% (30-of-38) and **Brad Sinopoli** is third at 78.6% (33-of-42).

2. TEAM NOTES & TRENDS – EDMONTON VS HAMILTON:

- **Head-to-head at 5-2 – best in 17 years:** Both clubs come into this game at 5-2 and with a share of first place in their Divisions. It is their best combined W-L record at **10-4 .714** going into a head-to-head meeting in 17 years since **August 7, 1998** when they were each at 4-1 and in first place in their Divisions with a combined **8-2 .800 record**.
- **Advantage Edmonton?:** This Week #9 marquee matchup features two absolutely dominant home teams in 2015. They are a combined 6-0 with a scoring edge of **232 to 73** (+ 26.5 scoring margin). Edmonton has won their last 7 home games by an average margin of **27.1 points**, Hamilton has won their last 9 home games by **14.4 points** per game. So the venue may have an effect between the CFL's two hottest teams.
- **Edmonton dominance at home:** The Eskimos have won their last 7 home games and all by margins of 17+ points (includes the final two home games of 2014). In that 7-game span, their margins of victory have averaged 27.1 points (243 to 53). Over their last SIX home games they have won each by at least 24 points. **In the entire history of the CFL, before this run no team has ever won 6 consecutive home games by 24 points or more.** Previous record: Edmonton 1957-58 5 in a row.
- **Edmonton trailing at home in 2015:** The Eskimos have trailed an opponent at home this year for exactly **5:19 out of 180:00** played at Commonwealth Stadium. Only Winnipeg on Jul 25/15 led at all and that by just 3-1 briefly for just over 5 minutes. Edmonton has not trailed at home in the last 100:04 of play.

- **Edmonton defence - 0 for 49:** The Eskimos' defence at home has been absolutely dominant and they have not allowed even one opponent TD drive in 49 possessions. Here is a look at relevant stats home/away in 2015:

- **Edmonton under Chris Jones:** In his two years as the Eskimos' head coach a few facts and figures stand out ...
 - CFL defensive rank: #1 (277.4 yards allowed per game)
 - Times allowing 19 points or less: 13 (record in those games 13-0)
 - Record when leading after one quarter: 10-1
 - Record when leading after 3rd quarter: 14-2
 - Record in July-August: 12-3 (5-5 post-August)
 - Record when they make less turnovers: 10-1
 - Home record at Commonwealth Stadium: 10-2 (they were 1-8 at home in 2013)
- **Hamilton Under Kent Austin:** T
- **Hamilton's Fast Starts:** Hamilton has started fast for the second consecutive week with **21-0** margins after the 1st Quarter. It was only the second time in 107 years of our history that any team had ever had **consecutive leads of 21+ points after 15:00 of play**. Only Winnipeg in August 1994 with 21-0 and then 25-0 leads in back-to-back weeks at the end of the 1st Quarter had ever achieved that feat.
- **Excellent QB Records:** Edmonton has used four different QBs at times this season but in terms of wins none better than **Matt Nichols**. His W-L record of 5-1 is # in the CFL. Last week Nichols left the game mid-way through the 3rd Quarter with a contact problem and James Franklin finished the last 6 Edmonton drives. For Hamilton, **Zach Collaros** has 5-2 mark and has **started the last 18 Ti-Cats' games with a 13-5 .722 record**.
- **Zach Collaros – 10 TD drives in last 3 games:** In Hamilton's first 4 games, he led them to just 6 TD drives in 48 possessions (**12.5%**). Over the last 3 games, that has been raised to ... 10 TD drives in 38 possessions for a **26.3%** mark – more than double). His passer rating split - first 4 games: **94.1**; last 3 games: **134.1**.
- **Hamilton win streak:** The Ti-Cats are riding a 4-game win streak and a win would give them their longest winning run since 6 in a row in 1998. They started that Grey Cup year at 0-1 and quickly got to 6-1.
- **Hamilton QB Sacks:** The Hamilton defence has really stepped up of late and over the last two games they have as many sacks as they made in the season's first 5 games (11). Hamilton is now the only CFL club with 5 players with at least 3 sacks each.
- **Hamilton last week vs BC – first time in 10 years:** The Ti-Cats scored TDs in four different ways vs BC. They passed for 4 TDs, and had interception, fumble and punt return scores as well. They are the first club to record **three separate types of return TDs in the same game in 10 years** since BC had an INT, punt and kickoff return on **Sep 8/05**. The last time Hamilton had 3 return types in one game was **Aug 5/99** vs Saskatchewan (INT, fumble, punt).

2. TEAM NOTES & TRENDS – EDMONTON VS HAMILTON:

- **Shakir Bell:** The Eskimos are now **4-0** in the four games that Bell has started at running back. He has averaged a league-high 84.5 rushing yards per game and 6.8 yards per carry - #2 among running backs.
 - **Grant Shaw:** Went into last week's game having made 21 consecutive field goals but ended that quickly by going 0-for-3 right up until the final play of the game. Shaw then made a clutch 28-yard FG to win the game. His 21 in a row was one short of Sean Fleming's club record of 22 straight made FGs. Last week, Shaw's punting was a key part of in Edmonton's win as he trapped Montreal inside the 20 three times and inside the 10-yard line twice.
 - **Hamilton on Offence:** In the last 3 games, Hamilton has averaged only 62 yards on the ground and as a % of total yards gained has been just 18%. They have passed for 841 yards over those 3 games (82% of the total).
 - **Devin Bailey & Cory Watson:** Over the first 5 games Bailey was the target on just 3 pass attempts. In the last two games he has been thrown to 10 times with 5 catches for 86 yards. Cory Watson has been targeted just 3 times in the last 3 games.
 - **Putting Opponents in 2nd-&-long:** Hamilton's defence has forced opponents into 90 times this season where they have been converting at just 35% for the year. Edmonton is #1 in that category with 107 opponent 2nd-and-7+ situations forced. Edmonton opponents convert at just 26% compared to 56% at 2nd-&-6 yards or less.
 - **Edmonton's leading receiver:** Game-by-game Edmonton has had a different leading receiver from the previous week all season long. Four different players have led the way with Kenny Stafford on top 3 times, Adarius Bowman twice plus Kendial Lawrence and Derel Walker once each.
 - **Derel Walker:** Got his CFL career off to a great start with 10 catches for 125 yards. He was the #1 target for Edmonton QBs vs Montreal and was thrown to **13 times**, as many as the next two receivers combined.
 - **Hamilton Defence vs BC:** The Tiger-Cats 'D' started tough against BC holding them to six 2-&-outs in the first seven possessions, forcing two fumbles by Andrew Harris, and just 36 net yards in that span. For the game, they forced 11 2-&-outs and scored 23 points off 4 BC turnovers.
 - **Hamilton's 52 points:** They have now hit for 52 points twice this season and that is the most they have scored since scoring 55 in 2011. It is only third time in club history they have gone for 50+ more than once in the same year (1999: 50+ points 3 times).
 - **4th Quarter scoring edge:** Over the last two years Edmonton has a margin of +91 in 4th Quarter scoring (212-121).
