HISTORICAL NOTES:

- Canadian Football governing bodies were the CRU (Canadian Rugby Union) until 1955, and the CFC (Canadian Football Council) for 1956-57. The CFC was renamed the Canadian Football League in January 1958.
- The present-day CFL East Division was formed from the long-standing IRFU founded in 1907. It was renamed the Eastern Conference in 1960 and the East Division in 1981. The CFL West Division was formed as the WIFU in 1936, renamed the Western Conference in 1961, and the West Division in 1981.
- Division Semi-Finals have been held in the one-game format across the CFL since 1965. The two-game format was used in the East only in 1951 and in the West from 1952 to 1964.
- In the East, Division Finals were staged as a 2-game total point series in most seasons from 1936 to 1972. The East adopted the one-game final format in 1973 with the exception of 1986 when there was a two-game Final only.
- In the West, Division Finals were staged as a two-game total point series in most years from 1936 to 1949 (1947 required a third game to break a tie). From 1950 to 1971, West Division Finals were staged as best-of-three series. The one-game final format began in 1972 in the West.
- ORFU champions played IRFU winners from 1945 to 1952 and the WIFU final winners in 1953 and 1954.
- Regina did not play in the 1936 Grey Cup due to a rules dispute.
- Winnipeg did not play in the 1940 Grey Cup due to a rules dispute.
- Division results shown for 1941 are from the ECRFU.
- In 1945, the WIFU did not conduct a regular season.

**Notes:** In order to support World War II efforts, the IRFU dissolved itself on July 24, 1941. The league did not operate from 1941 to 1944 before resuming play in 1945. At the July 1941 meeting, that year's season in the East was saved by formation of a new league called the Eastern Canada Rugby Football Union which added Toronto Balmy Beach as a replacement for the Hamilton Tigers who had withdrawn from the IRFU three weeks earlier. The ECRFU included the existing Toronto and Ottawa clubs along with the Montreal Bulldogs and was run as a completely separate entity. The 1941 Eastern season is NOT considered to be part of the contiguous IRFU / CFL East Division history as are results from the Service Era games conducted from 1942 to 1944. The WIFU shut down after the 1941 season with play resuming in time for the 1945 playoffs i.e. no 1945 regular season.

**RETURN TO THE POST-SEASON:** This Sunday, the Toronto Argonauts will make their return to the Grey Cup Playoffs as they visit the Hamilton Tiger-Cats at Tim Hortons Field for the Eastern Semi-Final. Having missed the 2014 playoffs with an 8-10 record by way of a crossover, the Argonauts will see their first post-season action since hosting the 2013 Eastern Final against the Tiger-Cats at Rogers Centre.

Since that meeting the two club's have met a total of six occasions over the last two regular seasons, which has resulted in the Tiger-Cats taking four of them.

As a head coach, Scott Milanovch has led his team to a 3-1 record in the post-season, including the 100<sup>th</sup> Grey Cup Championship in 2012. The Argonauts have only appeared in one Eastern Semi-Final since his first season as head coach which saw the Boatmen overcome the Edmonton Eskimos 42-26 on home turf.

The last time the Argonauts and Ticats met in an Eastern Semi-Final was in 2010 at old Ivor Wynne Stadium. The Double Blue, led on offence by QB Cleo Lemon, won the game 16-13 to advance.

**ARGOS AT THE DONUT BOX:** On Sunday afternoon in Hamilton, the Argos will be looking to overcome their recent struggle at Tim Hortons Field. Since Hamilton's new stadium officially opened in 2014, the Argonauts have played a total of five games at the THF – three as the visiting team vs. the Ticats and two as the home team – all of which have resulted in losses for the club.

**PLAYOFF RAY:** Following the Argonauts' 21-11 win vs. the Winnipeg Blue Bombers in their season finale last week, head coach Scott Milanovich revealed that veteran quarterback **Ricky Ray** would lead the offence in the playoffs. As an Argonaut, Ray has started four playoffs games, including the 100<sup>th</sup> Grey Cup, dating back to his first season in Toronto in 2012. In four post-season starts with Toronto, the veteran signal caller has completed 91-of-129 passes (70.5%) for 1,198 yards and seven touchdowns to just one interception. Ray has also led the Boatmen to a 3-1 record in post-season with his only loss coming in a 36-24 loss to the Hamilton Tiger-Cats in the 2013 Eastern Final. In that same game Ray threw for 329 yards and two touchdowns.

**THE AERIAL CONNECTION:** Looking at the 2015 Argonauts roster, only one of **Ricky Ray's** prominent targets from the 2012 Grey Cup Championship team remains on the Double Blue's 46-man active roster, **Chad Owens**. The Ray-Owens connection through the Argonauts passing game is one that cannot go unnoticed as Owens has been one of Ray's favourite targets over the past four seasons. Since 2012, the two have connected 23 times for a total of 361 yards and one touchdown in four post-season games.

There are 11 Argos players from the GTA including: DB **Matt Black**, WR **Kevin Bradfield**, RB/SB **Andre Durie**, OL **Jeff Keeping**, OL **Wayne Smith**, LB **James Yurichuk**, DB **Jermaine Gabriel**, DL **Ricky Foley**, OL **Matt Sewell**, WR **Natey Adjei** and DB **Shane Herbert**.

**NEWS & NOTES:**

- Canadian linebacker **Cory Greenwood** is eligible to make his return to the Argonauts defence this week after missing the last six games with an injury. Greenwood's last start was in Toronto's meeting with the Ticats in the Labour Day Classic at Tim Hortons Field. Prior to being sidelined, he registered 36 defensive tackles, three special teams tackles and a sack in eight regular season games.
- WR **Tori Gurley** finished as the co-league leader in the touchdowns with 10. The South Carolina product hauled in 58 passes for 791 yards to go along with his 10 touchdowns. In three games vs. the Ticats this season, Gurley posted 16 receptions for 199 yards and two touchdowns. He posted his first 100-yard receiving game in the Boatmen's final regular season meeting with the Tabbies on September 7.
- Rookie WR **Vidal Hazelton** led the Argonauts in receptions and receiving yards during the regular season. In 16 starts, Hazelton hauled in 70 passes for 803 yard and six touchdowns. Hazelton ranked second among CFL rookie pass catchers behind Edmonton's Derel Walker. The former Cincinnati Bearcat caught 64.8 of the passes thrown his way this season. In the Argonauts first meeting with the Ticats on August 3, Hazelton recorded his first 100-yard receiving game with 10 catches for 138 yards and a touchdown in the loss.
- In two of their three meetings with the Ticats, the Argos led in time of possession – 31:52 on Aug. 3 at HAM & 33:04 on Sept. 11 at HAM.
- Last week vs. Winnipeg, rookie receiver/ kick returner **Diontae Spencer** compiled 123 receiving yards on eight receptions to post his first career 100-yard receiving game. The first-year Argonauts finished the night with a combined 133 yards.
- East Division All-Star **Greg Jones** was a sure-handed tackler for the Argonauts throughout the regular season. The Argonauts Most Outstanding defensive player racked up 98 defensive tackles and 17 special teams tackles this season. He registered 5+ tackles in 12 of the Argos 18 regular season games and his 98 tackles were the most tackles recorded by an Argonauts player since Robert McCune amassed 99 tackles in 2013.



- Last week vs. WPG, veteran receiver **Dave Stala** hauled two touchdown passes in the Argonauts 21-11 win. It marked the first time since September 28, 2012 that the man known as Sticky Stala has caught a touchdown. It was also the first time since the same date that he caught multiple TDs in a single game.
- Argonauts K/P **Swayze Waters** will return to the lineup this week vs. the Hamilton Tiger-Cats. The 2013 East Division's Most Outstanding Player has missed a total of 14 regular season games this season due to a lower body injury. In his four appearances in the regular season, Waters hit four field goals with a long of 43 yards and punted 27 times for 1,298 yards (LG 82).
- Since signing with the Argonauts in 2012, **Ricky Ray** has faced off against the Ticats a total of nine times, including the 2013 Eastern Final. In those nine games, Ray has completed 277-of-326 passes for 2,834 yards and 14 touchdowns to six interceptions.
- The Argonauts defence had a knack of getting after the quarterback in the latter half of the season. Since their last meeting with the Ticats, the Boatman registered a total of 18 sacks since September 11. The Argonauts sack machine has been powered by defensive linemen, **Tristan Okpalauugo, Ricky Foley, Euclid Cummings and Cleyon Laing**, the Argonauts Most Outstanding Canadian. The four have combined for 33 of the club's 38 sacks this season – Okpalauugo (11), Cummings & Laing (8), Foley (6).

#### **COACHES**

**GM/Head Coach Kent Austin** – Austin got his second CFL coaching job with the Argonauts when he was hired to be the team's offensive coordinator in 2004. It was with the Argonauts where Austin got his reputation as a quarterback whisperer, helping Damon Allen lead the Argonauts to the 2004 Grey Cup Championship, in which Allen was named Most Valuable Player, and helping the quarterback to a CFL's Most Outstanding Player award in 2005. Austin remained in Toronto through the 2006 season before heading to his first head coaching position with the Saskatchewan Roughriders.

**Defensive Coordinator Orlondo Steinauer** – Steinauer spent eight seasons roaming the Argonauts' secondary as a player, where he was a four-time CFL All Star and was named the Argos' defensive player of the year in 2002. After his playing career finished, Steinauer returned to the Argonauts as a defensive backs coach, a position he filled for three seasons including a 2011 season which saw him take over defensive coordinator duties as well. Following the Argos' 2012 Grey Cup victory, Steinauer was hired by Austin to be the defensive coordinator for the Tiger-Cats.

**Defensive Backs Coach James Stanley** – Stanley was hired by the Argonauts in 2012 and served one season as the team's linebackers coach. After winning a Grey Cup with Toronto, he followed fellow Argo Orlondo Steinauer to the Tiger-Cats in 2013, where he now serves as the defensive backs coach.

**Assistant Defensive and Special Teams Coach Marcello Simmons** – Simmons began his coaching career with the Argonauts, joining the team in 2003 as the special teams coordinator and defensive backs coach. He served in both roles for six seasons, departing Toronto for the NFL before returning to the CFL with the Eskimos and now the Tiger-Cats.

#### **PLAYERS**

**DB Jalil Carter** – Carter spent three seasons (2012-14) with the Toronto Argonauts, winning his only Grey Cup Championship with the club in 2012.

**RB Anthony Woodson** – Woodson spent two seasons with the Argonauts before signing with the Tiger-Cats prior to the 2015 season. From 2013 to 2014, the national RB rushed 18 times for 54 yards while adding eight receptions for 60 yards.

**WR Spencer Watt** – Watt was drafted by the Argonauts in the third round (18<sup>th</sup> overall) in the 2010 CFL Draft and suited up in 76 regular season games with the Argos over five seasons. He recorded 135 catches for 1,715 yards and nine touchdowns in Double Blue before signing with the Tiger-Cats as a free agent in 2015.

**WR Terrell Sinkfield** – Sinkfield began his CFL career with the Argonauts in 2014 after signing as a free agent. Sinkfield played in five games with the Argonauts, recording seven catches for 90 yards and a touchdown while also returning 11 kickoffs for 240 yards. Sinkfield was released by the Argonauts on August 26 and was signed by the Tiger-Cats on September 4.

**OL Jeremy Lewis** – Lewis spent the 2014 training camp with the Argonauts before being released by the team on July 8. The Tiger-Cats signed Lewis following his release and he started 10 games in his CFL rookie season.

**LS Aaron Crawford** – Crawford was selected by the Argonauts in the sixth round (40<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2012 CFL Draft. Crawford was released by the Argonauts following training camp.

**QB Zach Collaros** – Collaros spent two seasons in the Double Blue after first signing as a free agent in 2012. Collaros filled in for an injured Ricky Ray during the 2013 season, completing 190 of 287 pass attempts for 2,316 yards and 14 touchdowns to six interceptions. Following the 2013 season, Collaros signed as a free agent with the Tiger-Cats and is now in his second season as the team's starting quarterback.

**OL Wayne Smith** – Smith was a first overall selection by the Tiger-Cats in 2004 and made an immediate impact, starting all 18 games his rookie season and being nominated as Hamilton's Most Outstanding Rookie. After two more seasons in Hamilton, Smith was traded to the Saskatchewan Roughriders in 2007, but returned to Hamilton in 2011. Following the 2011 season Smith signed as a free agent with the Argonauts, where he was a member of the 2012 Grey Cup winning team.

**WR Dave Stala** – Stala joined the Tiger-Cats in 2009 and spent five seasons in Hamilton, recording three 700+ yard seasons including a 2010 season which saw him record 1,015 yards and six touchdowns. Stala was signed by the Argonauts as a free agent this year after spending 2014 in Montreal.

**LB Brandon Isaac** – Following his release from the Argonauts in 2013, Isaac travelled down the QEW to Hamilton and spent the latter part of the season with the Tiger-Cats. Isaac recorded 22 tackles, four sacks and an interception with the Ticats in 2013 and played in the team's Grey Cup loss to the Saskatchewan Roughriders.
