2016 CFL GAME NOTES • HAMILTON AT TORONTO



1. CFL-Wide Trends Heading into 2016:

- **Season #59 / #103:** The founding leagues of the CFL were formed in 1907 in the East (as the IRFU or Big Four), and in the West in 1936 (as the WIFU). These two formerly independent leagues formally united in 1958 to form the Canadian Football League and standardize playing rules across the country. The 2016 CFL year will mark the 103rd season of Canadian football, and the 59th as the CFL itself.
- **CFL Season Openers – Surprising AWAY Teams Success:** The Argos and Tiger-Cats meet in the season opener in 2016, the first time that they have been the league's opening act since 2009. Going back to 1958 and the formation of the CFL, the AWAY club has won MORE times than home clubs leading 32 wins to 25 with one tie (**56% of the time**). That bucks the long-term trend of home teams winning 58% of all games to away clubs at 40% (the other 2% were ties).
- **CFL Season Openers II:** The Tiger-Cats will look to make it 7 times in 10 years that the visiting team has won the first game of a CFL season. In the last four years, only Winnipeg in 2014 won Game #1 at home.
- **Changing Eastern champions:** In the East, there have been **FOUR** different regular season champions in the last FOUR years – a result that had not happened since 1974. Ottawa made it four last year bouncing back to 12-6 from 2-16 to capture the automatic berth in the 2015 East Final. In the 1971 to 1974 run, Toronto in 1971 then Hamilton, followed by Ottawa and Montreal (1974) made it four different first place finishers in four years.
- **West repeat champions?:** The Edmonton Eskimos look to repeat for the first time since they ran off three straight years from 2001 to 2003. The greater trend however is that they will be trying for the West's third consecutive repeat regular season champion (BC 2011-12, Calgary 2013-14).
- **2015 over 2014:** The 2015 season was a year for the offence to recover as scoring went back up 8% to 49.2 points per game from just 45.5 per game in 2014. That 45.5 points per game was the lowest CFL-wide average since 1985. Net offence also rebounded last year by 4% to 677 yards per game in total from a 35-year low of just 652 per game in 2014.
- **Rushing TDs – where did they go?:** In 2015 league-wide, the rushing TD became scarce as just 98 were scored all year long. That was a drop from 124 in 2014 and the lowest since 1979 (when there 98 that year too). Of the 357 offensive touchdowns scored in 2015, 72.5% were accomplished via the pass.
- **2015 Eastern domination:** The East snapped a 10-year drought in winning more inter-divisional games than the West in 2015. Eastern clubs won 22 of the 40 games and captured the season series for the first time since 2004 when they went 23-17.
- **The Era of the great CFL QB:** The current run of great quarterbacking in the CFL continues with an unprecedented three current starters in all-time Top 7 ranked by passing yards. Henry Burris ranks #3 at 60,950 yards, while Ricky Ray (52,486) needs just 770 more to pass Danny McManus for the #4 spot. Kevin Glenn sits at #7 with 46,266 yards and with a big year can become the seventh player to reach the 50,000 mark.
- **The Era of the great CFL FG Kicker:** Just as true is the success by current CFL field goal kickers. Four of the Top 5 all-time FG% leaders are in the CFL in 2016: #1 Justin Medlock (87.5%), #2 Rene Paredes (85.7%), #3 Sean Whyte (84.1%) and #5 Chris Milo (81.5%). The CFL's #2 all-time scorer Paul McCallum just retired after 2015 and finished up at #7 with an 80.3% mark.
- **CFL Active Rushing Leaders – Burris & Harris:** The opposite is true for Rushing as the current highest ranked rusher is Henry Burris at **#32** (5,565 yards). The highest-ranked active non-QB among all-time rushers is Winnipeg's Andrew Harris at 4,259 yards and he sits at **#58** all-time.
- **Nik Lewis:** The CFL's active receiving leader is Montreal's Nik Lewis at 11,993 yards. He needs just 7 yards to reach 12,000 and 22 to move into 9th place past Derrell Mitchell (12,014 yards). Next down the Active List is Weston Dressler at #41 with 7,797 yards.
- **1000-yard receivers:** The CFL had 12 players go over 1,000 receiving yards in 2015, back up from just three in 2014. Of those 12 players from 2015, 10 have returned to their clubs in 2016 with two (Eric Rogers and Terrell Sinkfield) heading to the NFL.
- **Home vs Road Last Year:** Home teams won 45 of the 81 games in 2015 for a .556 mark, down from the .593 winning percentage by home clubs in 2014.
- **Returning with 254 wins:** hall of Fame coach Wally Buono of BC returns to coaching and brings 254 regular season victories. That compares to the 150 combined victories by the CFL's other eight head coaches. Calgary's Dave Dickenson and Edmonton's Jason Maas begin their head coaching careers, while Chris Jones starts anew in Regina with a 26-10 record.



2. Home Team Notes - Toronto:

- **Regular Season Game #1304:** The Argonauts have played more regular season games than any other club and this week marks #1,304 overall since 1907. Their all-time record is 621-656-26 and that includes 224 previous meetings against the Tiger-Cats (since 1950). Hamilton holds a 129 to 93 win edge over Toronto with two ties.
- **Argos' Roster Analysis:** The Argonauts start 2016 with 14 players out of their 55-man roster total that will be entering their first CFL season. That is the most in the CFL: Toronto 14, Winnipeg 11, Saskatchewan 10, Hamilton 10, BC 8, Ottawa 8, Calgary 7, Edmonton 7 and Montreal 6. That makes 81 first-year players across the CFL in 2016 for Week #1.
- **In Years #1-2:** Toronto's roster contains fully 28 players who will be in either their first or second year – that is 51% of the Argos complete roster, easily the highest percentage across the league (CFL average: 37%).
- **BMO Field:** With the 2016 opener set for BMO Field, this renewed (and new for the Argos) venue will be permanent home stadium #6 in their history. BMO follows a tradition started by Toronto home games at:
#1 Varsity Field-Stadium (1907), #2 Rosedale Field (1908), #3 Scarborough Beach Park (1922), #4 Exhibition Stadium (1959), and #5 SkyDome-Rogers Centre (1988). Add to that their temporary homes in 2015 at Tim Hortons Field, SMS Equipment Stadium in Fort MacMurray and TD Place in Ottawa and BMO Field becomes the #9 among places where the Argonauts have staged a home game.
- **Coach Milanovich:** The Argos leader will be entering his fifth consecutive season at the helm of the club matching Michael Clemons mark of starting off seasons (2003-2007). Before that, Bob O'Billovich was Week #1 head coach from 1982 to 1989.
- **Avoiding Penalties:** One area where Toronto should improve is in taking penalties. In 2015, they drew 225 which put them in #8 overall. Since 2012 they have finished #8, #7, #5 and #8 in drawing flags.
- **Ricky Ray – QB Start #192:** The CFL's #5 all-time passer will be making his 192nd career start at QB in the season opener. That will move him past Danny McManus and into #5 all-time behind: #1 **Damon Allen** 304, #2 **Anthony Calvillo** 277, #3 **Ron Lancaster** 257 and #4 **Henry Burris** 222.

3. Visiting Team Notes - Hamilton:

- **Franchise game #1061 / Hamilton game #1304:** The Tiger-cats will be playing their 1,061st regular season game in club history since the amalgamation of the old Tigers and Wildcats clubs after the 1949 IRFU season. If you include those two teams however and go back to 1907, Hamilton has been involved in 1,303 previous regular season games – exactly matching the Argonauts same total through 2015.
- **Ti-Cats' Roster Analysis:** Hamilton starts 2016 with the largest roster in the CFL at 62 players so they will have an extensive Injured List for Week #1 with the need to reduce to 46 players before game day. A total 23 players out of their 62-man roster total that will be entering either their first or second CFL season.
- **Jeremiah Masoli - QB Start #2:** The Ti-Cats announced Jeremiah Masoli as their starting quarterback for the 2106 opener in the absence of regular Zach Collaros. Masoli has not started a regular season game since July 18, 2014 – a 10-7 loss in which he went 9-of-20 for 107 yards, one interception and no TD passes. Masoli did start the 2015 East Final however in their 35-28 loss at Ottawa, and he was 30-of-42 for 349 yards and two TD passes.
- **Going for 10 wins:** The Tiger-Cats won 10 games last season will be trying to reach double-digits in consecutive season for the first time since back in 1999. Prior to the success of 1998-99 under Ron Lancaster you have to back to 1963-1965 under Ralph Sazio to get to the previous back-to-back 10+ win years.
- **6 years out of 7 and 7-of-8:** The Tiger-Cats have made the playoffs in 6 of the last 7 seasons, a run that was last matched from 1995 to 2001. They can make it 7 out of 8 years for the first time since making it in every year from 1978 to 1989.
- **Passing Success:** Hamilton's passing game has been among the CFL's best in recent years. They have not ranked below #2 in the CFL in passing yards per game since 2011. They were #1 in 2012 and finished at #2 in each of 2013 through 2015.
- **Creating Turnovers a Key:** Last year the Ti-Cats ranked #1 in the CFL with a +14 mark. They turned that into an incredible 8 defensive return touchdowns, their best mark since they had 8 in 1999. It was the first time that they led the CFL in Turnover Ratio since 2001 at +8.
- **Sacks Allowed:** Hamilton has allowed a total of 185 QB Sacks over the last three seasons ranking #8, #8 and #6 in those years.

THE BEGINNINGS FOR THE 'NEW' ARGOS: New ownership. New team. New motive. On May 20, 2015, the Toronto Argonauts were purchased by Larry Tanenbaum and Bell Canada. The new ownership group, which appointed Michael Copeland as the club's President and CEO on July 13, 2016, officially took over the club on January 1, 2016 in preparation for the Argonauts move to the newly-renovated BMO Field which is set to kick off on Thursday.

Thursday night's CFL opener at BMO Field will not only mark the Argos inaugural game and ribbon cutting at BMO Field but it will also be the club's return to the Canadian National Exhibition Grounds, where the club called Exhibition Stadium home from 1959 to 1988, prior to their tenure at Skydome/ Rogers Centre.

Despite playing one another 187 times in regular season play since the formation of the Canadian Football League in 1958, the Toronto Argonauts and the Hamilton Tiger-Cats have only been featured in the CFL's season-opening game in Toronto once before. That contest took place on July 12, 1989, during the Argonauts final season at Exhibition Stadium, and was won by Hamilton 24-15.

FIFTH TENURE: Argonauts head coach Scott Milanovich enters his fifth season with the club in 2016. Last season, the Argos bench boss led the Boatmen to a 10-8 finish in a tight East Division race and an appearance in the Eastern Semi-Final vs. the Hamilton Tiger-Cats. Since joining the Argonauts as a first-time head coach in 2012, he has posted a 38-34 record (.527), made three playoff appearances (2012 Grey Cup Champs, 2013 East Final & 2015 East Semi-Final), and led the league in most major passing categories over the last four seasons.

Thursday night's CFL season opener will mark the 10th time that Milanovich and Hamilton Tiger-Cats head coach Kent Austin have gone head-to-head in the regular season since their first meeting in 2013. Entering this week's game, Milanovich holds a 3-6 record vs. Austin after the Argonauts were swept in the season series between the two clubs last season. The last time the two clubs met for the Argonauts home opener was on June 28, 2013 when the Double Blue squeaked out a 39-34 win over the Ticats at Rogers Centre.

RAY DAY: After missing the first nine games of the 2015 regular season following shoulder surgery on his throwing arm during the 2014 offseason, 15-year veteran Ricky Ray will return to the helm of the Argonauts offence and be the club's starter on opening day. Ray closed last season as the club's signal caller, starting in final two games for the season and the Eastern Semi-Final. In two regular season starts he went 47-of-65 passing (72.3%) for 425 yards and two touchdowns.

As an Argonaut, Ray has gone 1,027-of-1,456 passing (70.5%) for 11,961 yards and 71 touchdowns to 28 interceptions in 69 regular season games over four seasons. In 25 career regular season games vs. the Tiger-Cats, Ricky Ray has posted a 17-8 record – his best career record and most wins vs. any CFL opponent.

STUBLER'S BACK IN TOWN: The 2015 offseason was a busy one for the Toronto Argonauts on many accounts, one of which involved the re-addition of Argonauts defensive coordinator Rich Stabler. Stabler, who enters his 29th CFL season coaching and his third tenure with the club, previously served as the Argos defensive coordinator in 1990 and from 2003-07. Known for his notoriously impenetrable defence, the six-time Grey Cup winner as a coach guided the Calgary Stampeders to finish atop of the CFL in a number of major defensive categories in 2015, including: Total points allowed (1st - 290), Pass touchdowns allowed (1st - 22), Rush touchdowns allowed (1st - 4), Average points allowed (2nd -19.2), Average passing yards per game (2nd - 246.6), and Average yards per rush attempt (2nd - 4.6).

ROSTER CONTINUITY:

Looking back at the Argos 46-man roster for the 2015 Eastern Semi-Final in Hamilton on November 15, 2015, **28 of 46** players listed on the team's active roster are currently still with the club – 12 more players than the Argos returned from Week 20 in 2014 to Week 1 in 2015. On Thursday night at BMO Field, a number of Argonauts will get their first official taste of CFL action in front of what is expected to be an electric sold out crowd.



SOPHMORE YEAR: One of the biggest stories of the Argonauts 2015 season was the immediate impact and success of the Argonauts 'Big Three', Kevin Elliott, Vidal Hazelton and Tori Gurley. Together the dynamic trio hauled in 178 passes for 2,236 yards and 24 touchdowns.

FRIENDS NOW FOES: The 2015 offseason saw the Argonauts lock up a number of highly-touted free agents, three of whom previously played for the Argos QEW rivals the Hamilton Tiger-Cats. Newly acquired Argos Brian Bulcke, Bryan Hall and Justin Hickman, spent three, three and five seasons respectively, with the Ticats. Over the last two seasons, Hall and Hickman compiled a total of 105 tackles, two special teams tackles, 16 sacks, six forced fumbles with the Ticats; Bulcke missed part of 2014 and all of 2015 due to injury. On Thursday night, Hall and Hickman, who will start and appear in his 80th career CFL game, will both play in their first games on the other side of the stories Argos-Ticats rivalry.

QB Ricky Ray needs 5 passing touchdowns to pass Doug Flutie for 3rd on the Argos all-time list with 76 and is 6 touchdowns shy from passing Damon Allen for 2nd at 77.

QB Ricky Ray needs 2,011 passing yards to pass Damon Allen (13,974) for second most passing yards as an Argonaut.

QB Ricky Ray has attempted 1,456 passing attempts as an Argonaut. He needs to attempt 276 more passes to surpass Damon Allen (1,713) for second on the Argos All-time list.

QB Ricky Ray has completed 1,027 passes with the Argonauts since 2012. He needs just 25 pass completions to surpass Damon Allen (1,051) for second All-Time in Argonauts history in completions.

NEWS & NOTES:

- After suffering a season-ending knee injury vs. the Saskatchewan Roughriders in Week 2 of the 2015 season, Argos SB/RB **Andre Durie** will return to the lineup. Durie, one of the club's longest-serving members, is set to appear in his 105th career regular season game with the club as they get set to start their new chapter at BMO Field on Thursday night.
- **Ricky Foley** will appear in his 62nd game as an Argonaut on Thursday night. In 2015, he had 49 tackles, six sacks, one forced fumble and a blocked kick his first season back in Toronto.
- A handful of Argonauts have the potential to make their CFL debuts in Thursday's CFL season opener, notably 2015 CFL Draft pick **Sean McEwen**, and 2016 CFL Draft picks **D.J Sackey**, **Jamal Campbell**, **Declan Cross** and **Llevi Noel**.
- On November 15, 2015, when the Argonauts and Tiger-Cats last met in the Eastern Semi-Final, both **Kevin Elliott** and **Vidal Hazelton** missed the game due to injury.
- Argonauts safety **Jermaine Gabriel** will appear in his 50th career CFL game. Gabriel, who was originally selected by Toronto in the second round (17th overall) in the 2013 CFL Draft, re-signed with the club this offseason. Gabriel had a career-high 51 defensive tackles and two forced fumbles in 13 regular season games last season.
- Argos WR **Tori Gurley** posted 16 catches for 199 yards and two touchdowns in three games vs. the Ticats in 2015.
- 2015 East Division Most Outstanding Rookie **Vidal Hazelton** had an Argos 2015 season-high with 10 catches for 134 yards and a touchdown at Hamilton on August 3, 2015.
- Third-year linebacker **Cory Greenwood** missed 10 games in 2015 due to a concussion or injury. The Kingston, Ontario native posted a team-high nine defensive tackles in the Argos 25-22 Eastern Semi-Final loss at Hamilton in 2015.
- **Keon Raymond** will don Double Blue for the first time on Thursday night. Raymond spent the past eight seasons with the Calgary Stampeders where he was a two-time Grey Cup Champion and CFL All-Star. The St. Louis, Missouri native, who is familiar with Rich Stabler's defensive system, posted 41 defensive tackles, three special teams tackles, two sacks and a fumble recovery while leading the Stamps with four interceptions last season.

COACHES

GM/Head Coach Kent Austin – Austin got his second CFL coaching job with the Argonauts when he was hired to be the team's offensive coordinator in 2004. It was with the Argonauts where Austin got his reputation as a quarterback whisperer, helping Damon Allen lead the Argonauts to the 2004 Grey Cup Championship, in which he was named Most Valuable Player. Austin also aided Allen in his pursuit of the CFL's Most Outstanding Player award in 2005. Austin remained in Toronto through the 2006 season before heading to his first head coaching position with the Saskatchewan Roughriders.

Defensive Coordinator Orlando Steinauer – Steinauer spent eight seasons roaming the Argonauts' secondary as a player, where he was a four-time CFL All Star and was named the Argos' defensive player of the year in 2002. After his playing career finished, Steinauer returned to the Argonauts as a defensive backs coach, a position he filled for three seasons including a 2011 season which saw him take over defensive coordinator duties as well. Following the Argos' 2012 Grey Cup victory, Steinauer was hired by Austin to be the defensive coordinator for the Tiger-Cats.

Defensive Backs Coach James Stanley – Stanley was hired by the Argonauts in 2012 and served one season as the team's linebackers coach. After winning a Grey Cup with Toronto, he followed fellow Argo Orlando Steinauer to the Tiger-Cats in 2013, where he now serves as the defensive backs coach.

PLAYERS

RB Anthony Woodson – Woodson spent two seasons with the Argonauts before signing with the Tiger-Cats prior to the 2015 season. From 2013 to 2014, the national RB rushed 18 times for 54 yards while adding eight receptions for 60 yards.

WR Spencer Watt – Watt was drafted by the Argonauts in the third round (18th overall) in the 2010 CFL Draft and suited up in 76 regular season games with the Argos over five seasons. He recorded 135 catches for 1,715 yards and nine touchdowns in Double Blue before signing with the Tiger-Cats as a free agent in 2015.

OL Jeremy Lewis – Lewis spent the 2014 training camp with the Argonauts before being released by the team on July 8. The Tiger-Cats signed Lewis following his release and he started 10 games in his CFL rookie season.

LS Aaron Crawford – Crawford was selected by the Argonauts in the sixth round (40th overall) of the 2012 CFL Draft. Crawford was released by the Argonauts following training camp.

QB Zach Collaros – Collaros spent two seasons in the Double Blue after first signing as a free agent in 2012. Collaros filled in for an injured Ricky Ray during the 2013 season, completing 190 of 287 pass attempts for 2,316 yards and 14 touchdowns to six interceptions. Following the 2013 season, Collaros signed as a free agent with the Tiger-Cats and is now in his second season as the team's starting quarterback.

DL Delano Johnson – Johnson spent parts of two seasons (2014-15) with the Toronto Argonauts. He appeared in 12 games for the Argos registering 14 tackles, one sack and two forced fumble before being released by the club in 2015.

WR/KR Chad Owens – Owens was acquired by the Argonauts via a trade with the Montreal Alouettes in June 2010. In six seasons, with the Argos Owens played an integral part of the Argonauts offensive and specials success. In 2011, he became just the fifth player in league history to have over 1,000 punt and kick return yards in a season. A year later, the 2012 CFL Most Outstanding Player went on to set the all-time record for all-purpose yards in a single season. Owens let his mark all over the Argonauts All-Time record book in all-purpose yards, and in all three of the kick return categories.

COACHES

Defensive Coordinator, Rich Stubler – Stubler got his first job in the CFL with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats, hired out of his role as Colorado State's defensive coordinator. He led the Tiger-Cats defence for seven seasons between 1983 and 1989, and was at the helm of the Black and Gold defence for four Grey Cup berths, including the Ticats 74th Grey Cup Championship victory in Vancouver. During his time with the Tiger-Cats, Stubler produced 12 CFL All-Stars, including three-time all-star defensive linemen Grover Covington and Mike Walker.

PLAYERS

OL Wayne Smith – Smith was a first overall selection by the Tiger-Cats in 2004 and made an immediate impact, starting all 18 games in his rookie season and being nominated as Hamilton's Most Outstanding Rookie. After two more seasons in Hamilton, Smith was traded to the Saskatchewan Roughriders in 2007, but returned to Hamilton in 2011. Following the 2011 season Smith signed as a free agent with the Argonauts, where he was a member of the 2012 Grey Cup winning team.

DT Bryan Hall – Spent two seasons (2013-14) with Ticats before signing with the Argos in February 2016. Hall played in 33 games in Hamilton and racked up 69 tackles, seven sacks and two forced fumbles and made an appearance in the 102nd Grey Cup with Ticats.



DE Justin Hickman – Hickman spent five CFL seasons (2009-11, 14-15) with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats before signing with the Toronto Argonauts in March 2016. The 2011 CFL All-Star racked up 172 tackles, three special teams tackles, 36 sacks and 14 forced fumbles with the Tabbies. He started in the Ticats 103rd Grey Cup loss.

LB Brandon Isaac – Following his release from the Argonauts in 2013, Isaac travelled down the QEW to Hamilton and spent the latter part of the season with the Tiger-Cats. Isaac recorded 22 tackles, four sacks and an interception with the Ticats in 2013 and played in the team's Grey Cup loss to the Saskatchewan Roughriders.
