- 2013 season played at University of Guelph Alumni Stadium (during construction of Tim Hortons Field)
- First three games of 2014 season played at Ron Joyce Stadium at McMaster University (during completion of Tim Hortons Field)
- First Tiger-Cats home game at Tim Hortons Field: September 1, 2014 vs. Toronto
